Pat Aussem is the Associate VP of Consumer Clinical Content Development at Partnership to End Addiction. In this role she curates information on current substance trends, risk and protective factors, ways to intervene in youth substance use, parenting skills, and how to find and access quality evidence-based treatment along the continuum of care. She is a frequent spokesperson on topics such as vaping, marijuana, opioids, medications to assist treatment and co-occurring disorders.

Pat holds an MBA in Finance, Master's degree in Counseling Psychology and is a NY Licensed Mental Health Counselor and NJ Licensed Professional Counselor with a Master Addiction Counselor certification. She also has a small private practice in New Jersey serving families struggling with addiction and is on the board of Community in Crisis, a local non-profit focused on ending the opioid epidemic.
