Associate Professor, Psychiatry & Behavioral Sciences
University of Washington

Dr. Jason Kilmer is an Associate Professor in Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at the University of Washington (UW) and serves as an investigator on several studies evaluating prevention and intervention efforts for alcohol, marijuana, and other drug use by college students. In addition to research and teaching, he has worked extensively with college students and student groups around alcohol and other drug prevention programming and given presentations throughout his career (including student athletes, fraternity and sorority members, residence life, and first-year students), both at UW and on over 100 campuses across the nation.
