Parenting for the Summer Before College and Beyond

The last few weeks of high school and the summer before college can impact success at college. This presentation will provide strategies for how parents can influence their student's health and well-being during the transition from high school to college, while respecting the student's desire for independence and autonomy. Discussing academics, relationships, stress management, money, self-care, and substance use with your graduate before they start college can promote parent-student connectedness and reduce the likelihood of college non-completion.
